The Berard Team recently carried out the move of this double skinned tank barge measuring 300' x 54' x 20' and weighing 1200 short tons. Berard provided transport for the different construction phases and the final move into place for launching. Berard used 48 lines of PST/SLEs, (4) ppus and (4) 30 ft barge ramps to accomplish the move. The barge was rolled onto a 140' x 280' drydock. With ground conditions being poor, the team had to use steel plates that spanned approximately 300' from the last wheel to the beginning of the barge ramp. Berard accomplished this project in only two days from mobilization in to demobilization of equipment.
