10 axle lines of SPMTs, 2 power packs, barge ramps, steel plating & winch trucks A major EPC company contacted Berard for a solution to transport this unique module from a fabricator to a port for export. The module had 14 legs protruding below the transport surface, rendering a normal transport configuration not feasible. Berard worked with the fabricator to develop a transport mode using a 4 line and 6 line Scheuerle SPMT in a "V" combination, ensured the support points were adequate, and developed a workable load-out plan. When executed, Berard weighed the module, determined COG location, then loaded the module onto a deck barge and secured to Berard engineering specifications. The barge traveled to the Port of New Orleans, LA for direct loading to a vessel for export.

When a client needed several modules transported to North Dakota, they knew they could rely on Berard to handle it. The team was chosen to transport the modules from the fabricator in New Iberia, Louisiana to Dickinson, North Dakota. The team has transported 20 modules thus far ranging in weight from 42,175 lbs. to 89,880 lbs. with loaded heights up to 15'11" traveling through 8 states with Nebraska requiring night moves. The modules were weighed by the team before several cranes were used to load the cargo onto Berard's Goldhofer 6 axle extendable hydraulic trailer. This specialized trailer allows for maximum maneuverability combined with a low deck height making for a smooth 2,300 journey. The team accomplished the mission on time and incident free.







The Berard team once again took home the championship trophy in the Loreauville Tailgate Cookoff. The team also won the top award in the wild game division. The event is held annually to benefit St. Joseph's Church in Loreauville. The turnout was another great one for a great cause!



The World Championship Gumbo Cookoff was a great event attended by thousands in downtown New Iberia, LA. The Berard team has participated in the event for the past 10 years. A great time was had by all the team members and the gumbo was great to boot!
