Equipment Used: 52 axlelines of ESE's, 3 ppus, loading ramps, high volume water pumps and winch trucks and barge mounted winches for barge securement.

It was a monumental task four years in the making. This massive Kone Cranes material unloader crane was fabricated in New Iberia, Louisiana where the team loaded the 173' top heavy crane onto a deck barge. The crane then made it's way to the Port of Lake Charles where it had only feet to spare as it passed under high voltage power lines before it reached it's destination to be offloaded. Offloading is normally a cakewalk but this one was different. The crane had to first be rotated 90 degrees while on the barge to be in position to roll off onto the dock which was the equivalent of rolling 1500 tons onto an elevated concrete piling highway bridge. As the load rolled on to the dock the team executed a 90 degree left turn at the same time to line up the crane's trucks to the dock's rail system. Once in position, it was lowered onto the tracks and now the Port of Lake Charles Bulk Terminal #1 has a brand spanking new crane to service the many ships that come to the area.

We would like to thank the many people involved in this massive undertaking, especially our dedicated team members who worked tirelessly to accomplish this successful project for the record books!






























## Berard Breaks Ground
