



104 lines of SPMTs, loading ramps, high volume water pumps.

In last month's issue we featured a colossal jacket loadout and this month we feature the deck that will accompany it. The Berard Team used 104 axle lines of SPMTs to load out the massive 2,400 ton offshore deck from the fabrication area to a deck barge that will transport it to its meeting with the jacket offshore. Slow and steady was the name of the game and the team performed as planned and with safety in mind while the load moved onto the barge and into position for final securement for water transport. Once again, thanks to all of our team members for making this project another great one!

13 axle lowboy trailer

Berard Transported two 160,000 lb. desalter vessels from a fabrication shop in Louisiana to a heat stress facility, then back to the original fabrication shop two days later. Our new 13 axle lowboy rig was perfect for the job. With up to 60' of deck, and full steering capabilities, this trailer can maneuver into the most congested areas, while keeping the load as low as possible over the road to avoid overhead restrictions. This trailer also features a 10' width to ensure your cargo rides on the most stable equipment available.
