It was barge moving time once again for the Berard team with the load-out of this 300' long by 100' wide deck barge in Amelia, LA. The move marked a milestone for the client as the first barge built at a new fabrication facility. The team transported the barge from its fabrication position in the yard, executed a ninety degree turn to align with the drydock, and headed straight onto the drydock for launching. The entire move was completed over two days. Once the barge was lowered onto stands on the drydock, the transport equipment was removed, and the barge was launched ready for service.

Berard engineers designed full layout and securing plans for the top-heavy cargo for the safe and successful journey to Mexican oilfield waters.
