Job Specs

Dimensions:

Pigging Loop Skid: 82' x 26' x 28' 175 tons Compressor Module: 81' x 26' x 32' 300 tons

Equipment Used:

12 axle lines of Goldhofer PST-SLEs, 24 axles of Scheuerle SPMTs, 8 barge ramps, winch trucks, ballast pumps & load cells Berard played an instrumental role in the replacement of a compressor module for a new pigging loop module for a Gulf of Mexico oil platform. Berard first jacked up and weighed the new pigging loop module. This 175 ton module was then transported using 12 axle lines of Goldhofer PST-SLE transporters from the fabrication shop onto a deck barge. Due to shallow water at the roll-on site, Berard derived a roll-on plan using multiple ramp spans to climb onto the 16' deep offshore barge. Once on the barge, the package set sail for the oil platform in the Gulf of Mexico. The old compressor module was removed from the platform and set on the barge, and the pigging loop module was installed in its place. The compressor module returned to the fabrication yard, where Berard used 24 axle lines of Scheuerle SPMTs to transport the cargo from the barge and into storage.







Members of the Berard Team traveled to the peach state to attend and present at the 2015 Specialized Carriers & Rigging Association's Annual Symposium held in Atlanta, Georgia. Berard was invited to make a presentation about its SC&RA 2013 'Moving Job of the Year' award. The event was well attended by industry professionals from around the world along with vendors of all sorts of heavy transport equipment and services. A great event with great people and we look forward to next year's event.
