

South Louisiana swampland ground conditions called for the use of steel plating to make sure the load was evenly distributed as it made its way through the shipyard to its destination. The five mile move included maneuvering the 171 ton hull through city streets with several right turns as well as crossing a levee. The 12 axle lines of SPMTs helped make the move a successful one for the team and in the end, the mission was accomplished safely.
