48 axle lines of SPMTs, 4 power packs, crane mats, barge ramps, water pumps, beams and stands A new high efficiency power plant in South Louisiana was the perfect opportunity for Berard to utilize years of expertise with Mississippi River roll-off projects. Two turbines weighing 700,000 lbs. each and two generators weighing 600,000 lbs. each required delivery to the site. With the turbines being constructed in Savannah, GA, and the generators imported to the Port of New Orleans, Berard utilized an ABS deck barge to transport both to site. The turbine was loaded first in Savannah where it was secured for ocean transit. The barge sailed around Florida to New Orleans, where the generator was loaded along with the turbine. The barge then traveled the Mississippi River to a US Army Corps of Engineers controlled roll-off site. The packages were then rolled off from the deck barge to bank each using 24 lines of SPMTs, then transported 1 mile via state highways to the final destination. All 4 packages were rolled off and delivered to site in 2 days.

Delivery of electrical transformers often requires efficient delivery options, this 315,000 lb. transformer to central Louisiana was no different. Berard developed a plan using a suitable private rail spur 22 miles from the destination site. A feasibility survey was conducted to ensure a safe and on time delivery. The transformer was lifted from the railcar using hydraulic jacks then slid onto a 12 line Goldhofer THP trailer. The team then transported the transformer over multiple bridges to the destination, where the transformer was then slid over the pad where it was jacked down into final position. The entire operation was completed in 2 days.
