The Berard Team recently moved a one of a kind piece of cargo called Gwave™. The module is an experimental floating structure that will use the ocean's waves to generate power. The GWave™ module had to be loaded out from the fabrication yard and transported by deck barge to Berard's own storage facility located in Amelia, Louisiana. Once the module reached Berard's facility, the team began the off load of the 2,800 ton behemoth. It's a very unusual type of cargo that definitely has many people in the area talking.

Dimensions: 418'W x 107'L Equipment Used: 104 axle lines of SPMTs, loading ramps, 18 high volume water pumps, 425' x 126' x 25' deck barge, 65 ton winches and tugs The Berard Team once again played a pinnacle role in launching the Navy's newest addition to its fleet, USS Charleston—a 418'L x 107'W Littoral Combat Ship (LCS)—built with pride by Austal in Mobile, Alabama. Berard provided a turnkey service and accomplished the task using 104 axle lines of self-propelled modular transporters. The team rolled the 2,800 ton LCS from the final assembly bay to a waiting deck barge all in record time and keeping the project ahead of schedule. The LCS was then barged down river for trans-loading from deck barge to dry dock. The entire process was accomplished safely and in only one day. Congrats to the team members and everyone involved for another safely completed project!








