

Equipment Used: 112 axle lines of SPMTs, 4 PPUs, loading ramps, high volume water pumps and winches for barge securement

The Berard Team took part once again in launching another great asset for our US Navy. The team loaded out the USNS Burlington, a 2,200 ton Expeditionary Fast Transport ship (EPF). This type of vessel was formally classified as a Joint High Speed Vessel (JHSV). The team transported the Burlington from the client's final assembly bay to a deck barge. Once secured on the barge, it traveled down river to be trans-loaded. Once at the transfer point, the trans-loading of the Burlington onto the Alabama, an 800' floating dry dock, began. As usual, the trans-load went smoothly thanks to all involved. Through hard work and dedication, the job was completed safely and successfully in only one day.

Equipment Used

12 axle lines of SPMTs, barge ramps, laminated mats, stands & winch trucks It's time to go to work for this 160 ton electrical building. Fabricated in Belle Chasse, LA, but heading to be installed on a platform in Ingleside, TX, Berard got the call for delivery. Berard used 12 lines of Goldhofer PST-SLE transporters to lift the cargo from fabrication supports and roll-onto the barge. Berard engineers derived a roll-on plan, ballast plan, and securing plan for the barge journey to Texas. In one day the building was loaded and secured on the barge, which arrived at the destination 4 days later.
