36 axle lines of SPMTs, 4 power packs, barge ramps & winch trucks The team recently loaded out a massive tank barge for a major shipyard in South Louisiana. The barge weighing in at 958 tons and measuring 297' in length and 54' beam, was transported from the fabrication area of the shipyard and traversed the yard to the dry dock. The trip was a tight one with the team utilizing the maneuverability of the 36 axle lines of self propelled modular transporters to navigate the barge around the obstacles in the yard. Now at the dry dock, ballasting commenced and the team rolled the cargo on in minimal time, helping to get the barge on it's way to completion and delivered to the client. Berard has been helping shipyards just like this one keep tight schedules for decades. Let us bring that experience and dedication to your next project.







We're taking a look at the past in this month's issue as we feature a project from 1963. At the time, our company operated as Roy Berard & Sons, and the team transported this massive antebellum home by road and barge. This beautiful home was located near Franklin, Louisiana, relocated approximately 7 miles to Centerville, Louisiana on Louisiana Highway 182, or "Old Spanish Trail". The home was built in 1846, dubbed "Oak Bluff", later named "Bocage on the Teche", for its prominent location on the Bayou Teche. Roy Berard and his team was the only group willing and able to tackle such a project. Using eight trucks on four trailers, the team transported the structure onto and off of a barge. Careful planning ensured the structure and barge fit through the bridge along the bayou. Projects like these show Berard's ingenuity and dedication to quality, taking on the biggest challenges with the right equipment and personnel make each project a success.
