Load outs are something the Berard team is well versed in. For decades we've helped fabrication companies get their finished projects loaded and on their way to completion. We work flawlessly with client project managers to keep project delivery dates on schedule. This featured load out was another typical project for the team with the use of 36 axle lines of self propelled modular transporters (SPMT). The 759 ton module was lifted from the supports and transported to the client's bulkhead. The ground conditions called for plating to be positioned along the travel route to help support the load. The team then rolled the module onto the deck barge where it was sea fastened for water transit to the final location.
