# The Shipyard Launching LCS 34 Augusta



## Job Specs

**Weight:** 2,800 Tons

**Dimensions:** 418'W x 107'L

**Equipment Used:** 112 axle lines of SPMTs, 6 power packs, 2 deck spacers, loading ramps, 18 high volume water pumps, 425' x 126' x 25' deck barge, 65 ton winches and tugs

The Berard Team was proud to load out the Navy's newest addition to its fleet, USS Augusta—a 418'L x 107'W Littoral Combat Ship (LCS). This marks the 29th ship that Berard has launched for the client. Berard accomplished the load out & transfer using 112 axle lines of SPMTs. The team rolled the 2,800 ton LCS from the final assembly bay to a waiting deck barge on time and keeping the project on schedule. The LCS was then barged down river for trans-loading from deck barge to dry dock. The entire process was accomplished in only one day and most importantly, safely. Our team did a great job and we thank them and everyone involved for another successful project!

**Weight:** 490 Tons


## Dimensions:

## Equipment Used:

28 axle lines of SPMTs, 4 power packs, high volume water pumps, barge ramps, steel plating and winch trucks

The Berard team has been an asset to oil & gas industry fabricators for decades. Berard also serves the refurbish and recycle industries with load out and offload services. This was one such project for the team when a recycle client needed this offshore deck and jacket offloaded for recycling. The team used twenty-eight axle lines of SPMTs to lift and offload the deck and jacket. Once the cargo was offloaded, the team transported it to a staging area in the yard for future dismantlement by the client. The team worked tirelessly to get the project completed in one day, minimizing project costs for the client.
