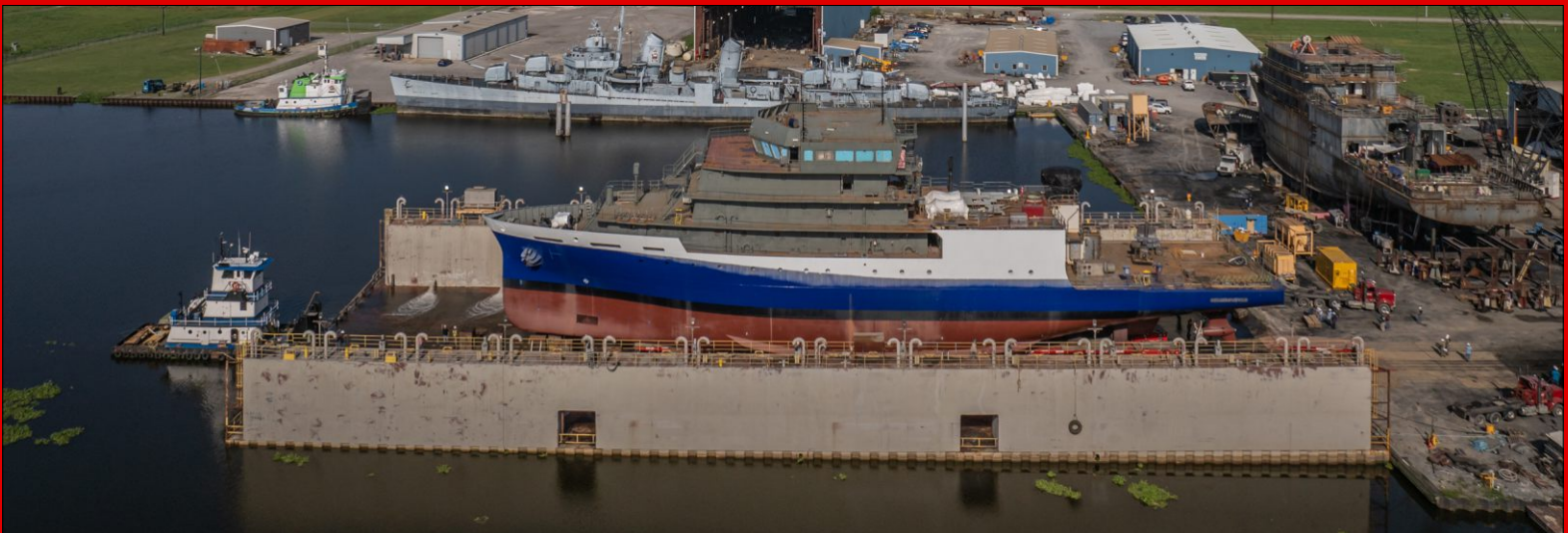

Big shipyard moves are our specialty and the bigger the better. The Berard team recently loaded out a massive NOAA NAV vessel for a South Louisiana shipyard client. Our team has done several large vessel load outs for this client and we were glad to assist them with yet another one. The team used a total of 60 axle lines of SPMTs to lift and transport the 1,926 ton vessel from the fabrication area to the client's bulkhead for the roll on sequence onto the dry dock. The Berard team coordinated with the client's dry dock ballast team to begin the transition from ground to the dock. This coordination made the load on process smooth and timely. Once in final position, the vessel was lowered onto pre-positioned supports and the SPMTs removed. It was another success for both Berard and the shipyard who was able to stay on schedule for this impressive build.

The Berard team put our new Faymonville HighwayMAX 3 trailer right to work with this 120 ton vessel hauled from Oklahoma to a project site near Baton Rouge, LA. With a gross weight of 380,000 pounds and a loaded height of 16' 6", Berard project managers and permitting experts first identified and surveyed a suitable route for the load. The transport team traveled the 1100 mile route in 4 days, safely delivering the cargo on time.

Amy Odom

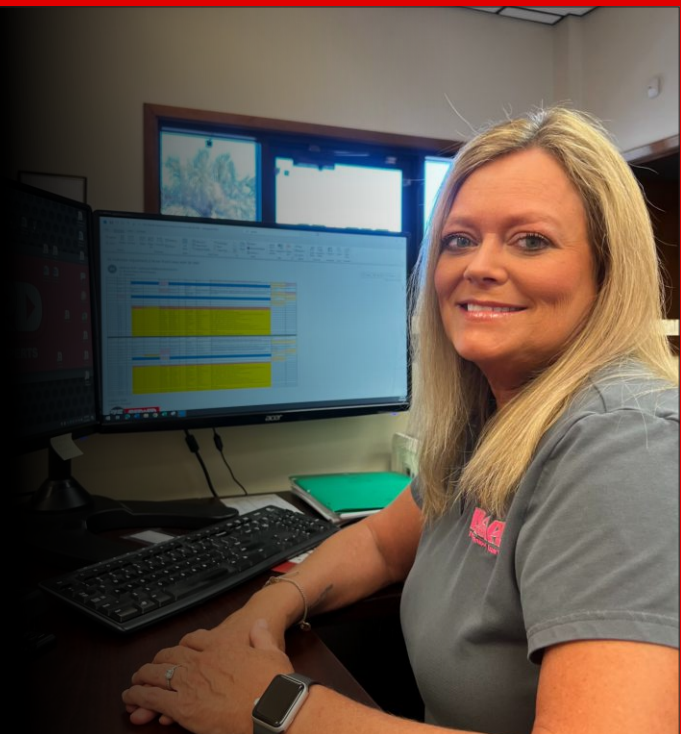
Office Administrator | Mobile, AL
